Application open only to TDF Members (exceptionally, to very active community members)
People who are already active in migrations/trainings (if not active, will have to get the training session)



## Improvement of Peer-to-Peer Reviews

Process is supposed to be "debugged"

**bre**Office

- Three step "peer-to-peer" review: Application, Request for Additional Info, Peer-to-Peer Review
- 1<sup>st</sup> Objective: Create a Set of Basic Questions (to ease the process, especially vs language issues)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Objective: Make the Process "Repeatable"
  - (process should not change according to reviewers)

- Monitoring for Quality Assurance
  - Activity report on current projects (every 6 months)
- Monitoring for Consistency
  - Request of updated materials at least once a year
- Conference
  - Warmly suggest participation to conference

  - Adapt to changing market conditions
