



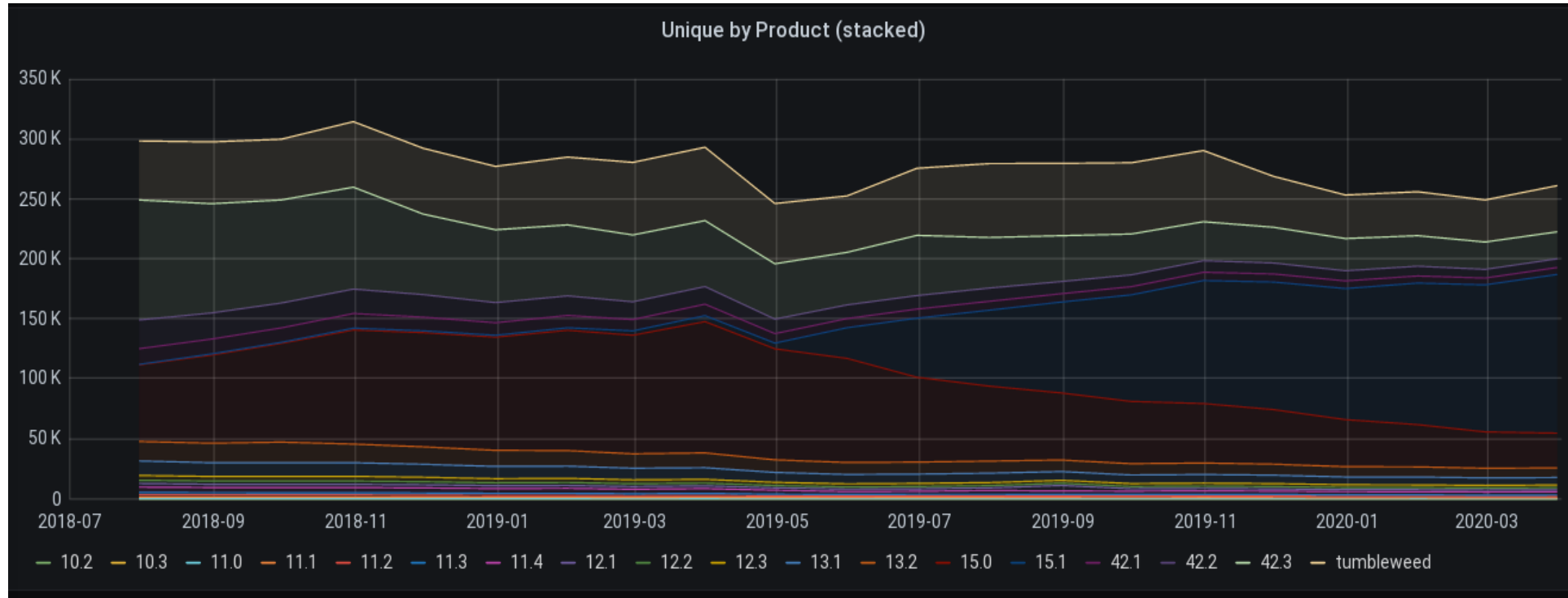

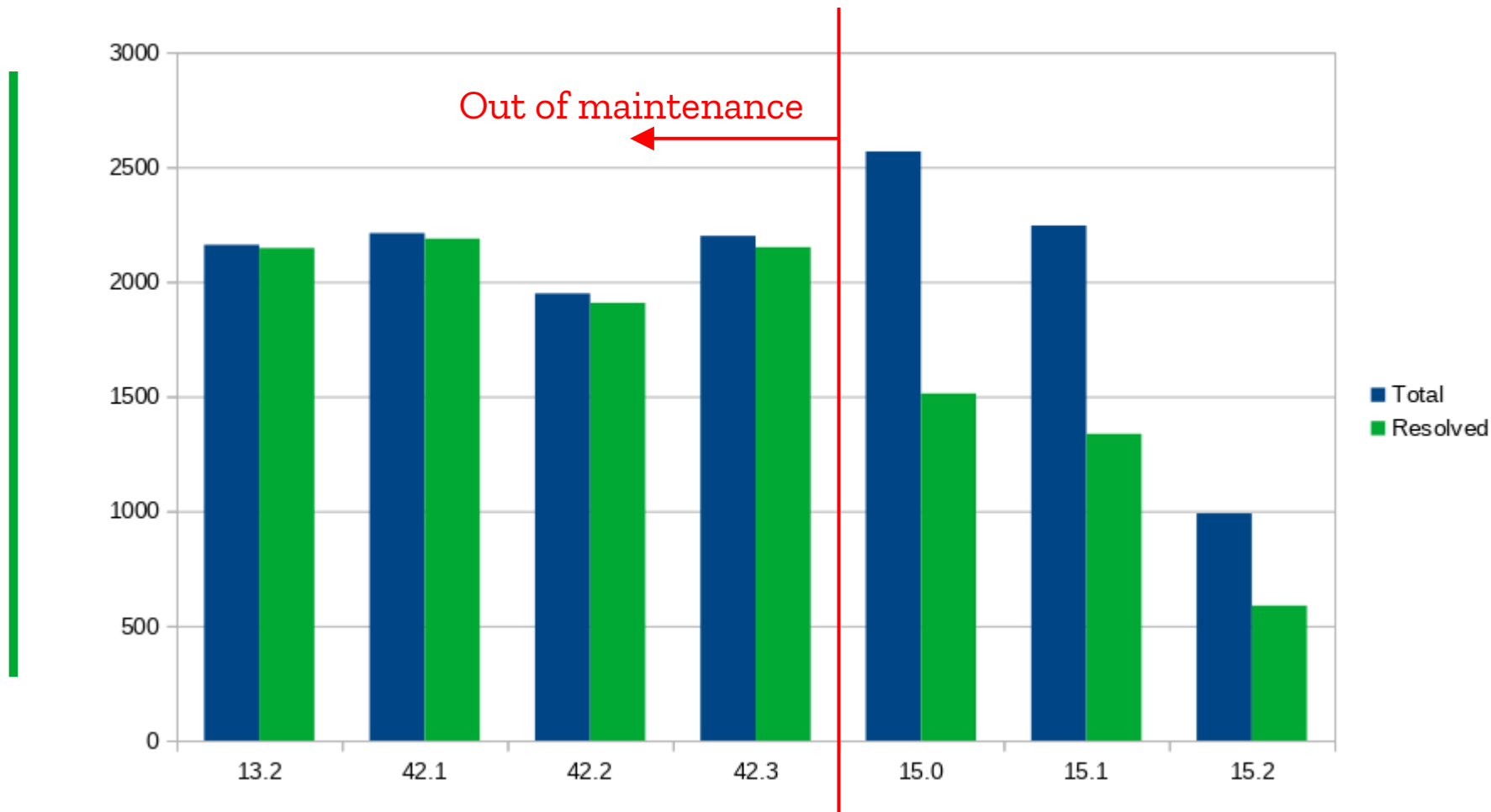

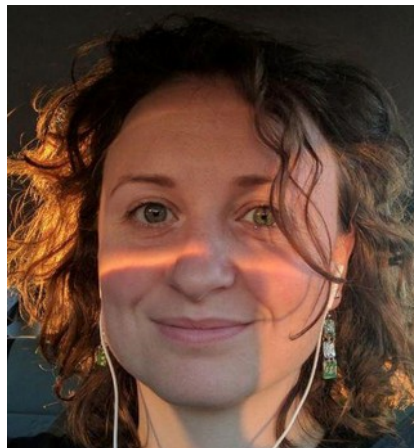
What happened since last oSC?

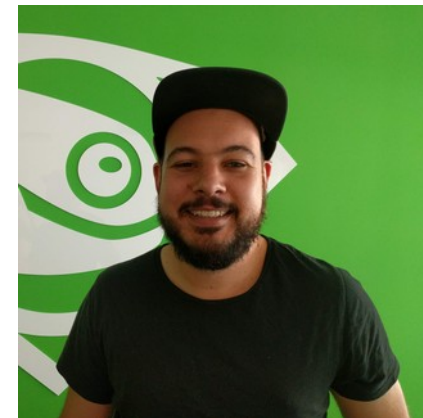

What happened since last oSC?

- OpenSUSE Asia Summit 2019 – successful event in Bali
- Asia Summit 2020 planned in Dehli
– postponed to 2021 due to COVID-19
- FOSDEM in February in Brussels
– big openSUSE booth, lots of positive feedback
- Alignment with OFE and FSFE
- 'Getting Started' with Linux Magazine

What happened since last oSC?

- Some hundred Tumbleweed snapshots
- Leap 15.2
- Started with 'Closing the Leap Gap' / Jump
- Leap 15.2.1 planned for November

What happened since last oSC?

- Significant changes to IT Infrastructure
 - Forums migrated from Provo to Nürnberg
 - Migration of Accounts to SUSE Infrastructure
 - Migration of Mailing Lists started
- Carve-out SUSE from Micro Focus and openSUSE from SUSE
